No known drug interactions, however, the calcium D-glucarate metabolite, D-glucaro-1,4-lactone, inhibits the enzyme beta-glucuronidase, reducing deconjugation of glucuronides in the intestine. Several medications are metabolised in the liver via glucuronidation. These medicines may be eliminated at higher rates when taken alongside Calcium-D-Glucarate.¹²
